This map takes you from Mile End Underground station to the Childrens Play Park. See back page for information about accessible facilities and bus routes.


The journey is around 440 metres long. It should take around 10 minutes to finish. If you have difficulty getting about, it could take 20 minutes.

Turn left outside Mile End Station, the Green Bridge is in front of you. Cross over Eric Street.



At the corner turn left and use the pedestrian crossing to cross Burdett Road.




Turn left and walk down Burdett Road.

For step-free journey cross to the left side of Burdett Road at the pedestrian crossing for Bow Common Road. Carry on along Burdett Road.




Cross back over to the right side at the next pedestrian. Carry on along the Burdett Road.

At the far end of Revolution Karting cross over St. Paul's Way and turn right.




Turn left onto Locksley Street. The entrance to the Children's Play Park is 40 meters down on the left.
