Re: SEA and HRA Screening Determination of the Roman Road Bow Neighbourhood Plan

This letter sets out the Council's screening opinion concerning the need for a Strategic Environmental Assessment (SEA) or Habitats Regulation Assessment (HRA) in relation to the Roman Road Bow Neighbourhood Plan, Regulation 14 consultation draft.

On the basis of the contents of the neighbourhood plan, and on consultation with the statutory bodies (Environment Agency, Natural England, Historic England), the following determination is made: an SEA and HRA of the Roman Road Bow Neighbourhood Plan is not required.

The reasons for this decision are set out in the accompanying Statement of Reasons, which includes the comments made by the statutory consultees.

This decision has been based on the information provided in the Regulation 14 consultation version of the neighbourhood plan. If the content of the neighbourhood plan significantly changes and/or there is a material change in the environmental characteristics of the locality, then this determination may be revisited to take account of those changes.
