

## THE TOWER HAMLETS LOCAL LIST

### What is the local list?

The local list identifies important heritage assets that are valued by the local community as being irreplaceable and contributing to the local environment by enhancing the streetscene and sustaining a sense of local distinctiveness. The list includes a variety of buildings, groups of buildings as well as other structures and features that are of local importance due to their architectural, historical and townscape significance.

Locally listed buildings are a type of 'non-designated heritage asset', which means that they have a degree of heritage significance that merits consideration in planning decisions. However, the local list is not an exhaustive list of all the non-designated heritage assets in the borough. These can also be identified in other ways including local and neighbourhood plans, conservation area appraisals and management plans and decision making on planning applications.

### What does it mean to be on the local list?

The purpose of the local list is to formally recognise the importance of these buildings and to ensure that care is taken when making decisions that may affect their significance as heritage assets. Planning permission is required for any works to a locally listed building that constitute development. However, it is not necessary to apply for listed building consent for works to a locally listed building.

Proposals to extend or alter a locally listed building should respect its character and significance. For example, proposed works should use appropriate materials and retain any features of architectural or historic interest. Proposals that result in the loss of, or harm to, the significance of a locally listed building will be resisted.

Some works may not require planning permission but should still be carefully considered. The removal of historic features or details can not only harm the special interest of the locally listed building but can also adversely affect its value. Research has shown that buildings which retain their historic features in good order hold their value better than those which have been unsympathetically altered.

## How to use the local list?

This document provides a schedule of all locally listed buildings in the borough. It is organised alphabetically according to street name. In some cases, a building may have more than one street address and will feature on the list more than once to enable it to be identified from each relevant address.

The list includes some war memorials. The local list status only applies to the memorial itself and does not include any other part of the host property.

The list should be used in conjunction with the council's interactive maps, which shows the location of the locally listed building.
